



KROC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Community Workshop

The Salvation Army Ray & Joan Kroc Center is pleased to provide a scholarship program to help provide access to The Kroc Center. It was Joan Kroc's vision and expectation that all individuals have equal opportunities to grow their natural gifts and talents.

How to apply

1. Pick up a scholarship application from The Kroc Center front desk.
2. Attach all household income verification documents to your completed application. This includes all documents that best reflect the gross annual salary income of all household members: check stubs, unemployment statement, social security, disability incomes, food stamps award letter, alimony, child support income, etc.
3. Return your completed application with attached household income verification to the front desk Monday–Friday between 9am–6pm at least one week prior to the next available workshop. Please allow 10–15 minutes for your application to be reviewed. If you qualify for a scholarship you will automatically be enrolled to attend the next available Community Workshop session. See upcoming workshop dates below. All previously submitted income verification documents will be returned.
4. Attend your scheduled Community Workshop. You must attend in order to be eligible for a scholarship.

Attending a Workshop

At the Workshop you will have the opportunity to learn about the large variety of activities, education classes, and personal enrichment programs that are offered at The Kroc Center.

Scholarship Program Policies

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM POLICIES

1. Head-of-household must attend a Scholarship Workshop.
2. All applicants must have lived within the greater North Idaho area for at least 3 months.
3. Completion of application does not guarantee assistance. Scholarships will be awarded based on eligibility, funding, timeliness, and space available.
4. Scholarships are valid for one year. At the end of the year, recipient will receive a courtesy reminder to reapply for their scholarship by attending a Workshop prior to the date their current scholarship expires.
5. An adult membership begins at the age of 19. A family membership is defined as a household with two adults (19 or over) and minor legal dependents living in that household. The ONLY two exceptions are as follows: If the third adult is disabled and is legally dependent on the adults in the household or if the third adult is elderly and is physically, emotionally, or legally dependent on the adults in the household. Proof of dependence is required for scholarship approval.
6. Scholarships for individuals and families are the same as regular membership categories. (The same rules and policy requirements apply to a scholarship membership). Categories are: Adult, Family, Family +5, Senior, Teen, Youth.
7. Scholarship recipients are expected to financially contribute toward the membership. If awarded recipients will be asked to pay 35% of the Silver Membership based on financial needs and other eligibility.
8. Approved scholarship recipients/families will benefit from a Silver Membership. In addition, the membership registration fee will be waived, the scholarship award will include 2 free coaching sessions with a fitness coach and a \$15 coupon to be used toward a program, class or Play Care. Coupon does not apply to membership, merchandise or café items. There is no cash value to the coupon.
9. Scholarship recipients receive 50% reduced rate on standard drop-in land and water fitness classes.
10. Scholarship recipients will be eligible for program scholarships up to 50% discount. In order to determine eligibility, please complete a Program Scholarship Request Form available at the Customer Service Desk.
11. Changes allowed to a scholarship membership within the scholarship year are the following: Birth in the family, Death of a member, Marriage/Divorce, Address and Contact Information change or a change in billing information. Scholarship recipient is allowed one member change to a scholarship, please note, the scholarship committee must review all proposed changes before implemented.
12. It is important that scholarships are awarded to individuals who use the center. We encourage a scholarship member to use the facility an average of 4 times a month.
13. All scholarships are confidential. Applicants agree to refrain from discussing awards with others.
14. If your scholarship lapses more than 30 days without payment, you will need to back-pay or reapply by attending a Community Workshop.
15. In order to be eligible to renew your scholarship you must attend two Life Skills Classes within a year of your original scholarship sign-up date. Being a Kroc Volunteer counts towards one life skill class.
16. If you fail to attend your scheduled workshop, you must contact us at 208.667.1865 within 10 days or your application will be shredded.
